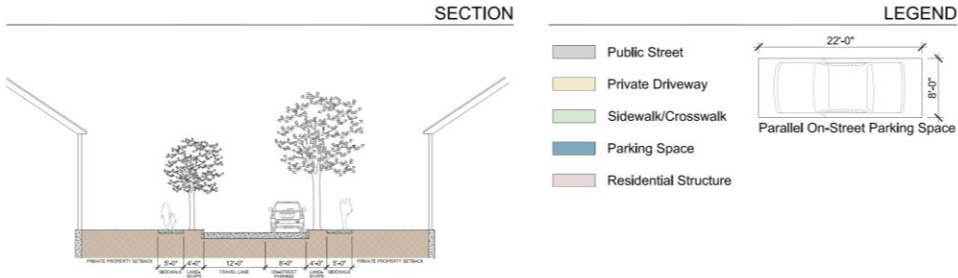
Example of Adding On-Street Parking

- Minimum 20' width required
- Account for intersections, driveways, hydrants, etc.
- Sidewalk improvements may be needed/desired

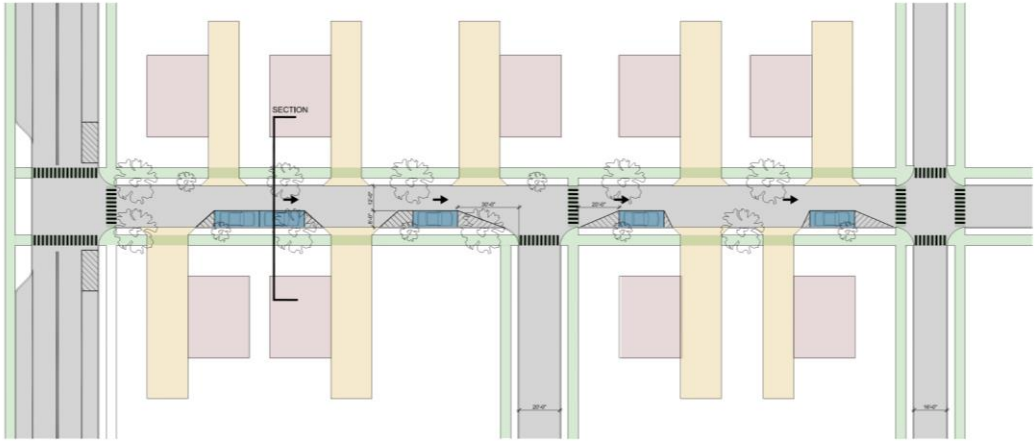

ONE WAY NEIGHBORHOOD STREET WITH ON-STREET PARKING



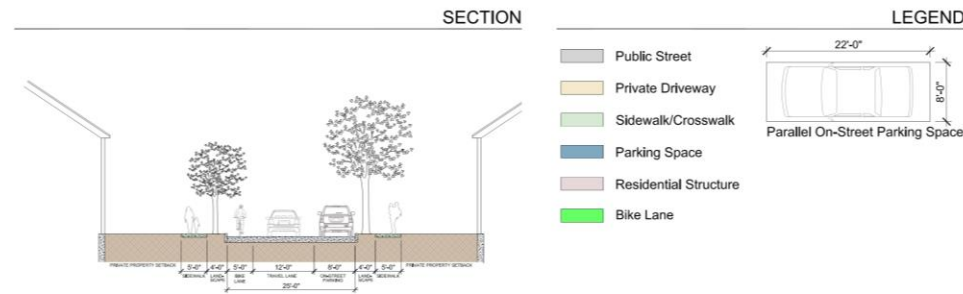
Adding On-Street Parking – Example with 25' Width

- Extra 5' is not enough for additional travel or parking lane
- Could use the space for a 5' bike lane if desired
- Alternatively, space could be used for additional sidewalk or landscape area

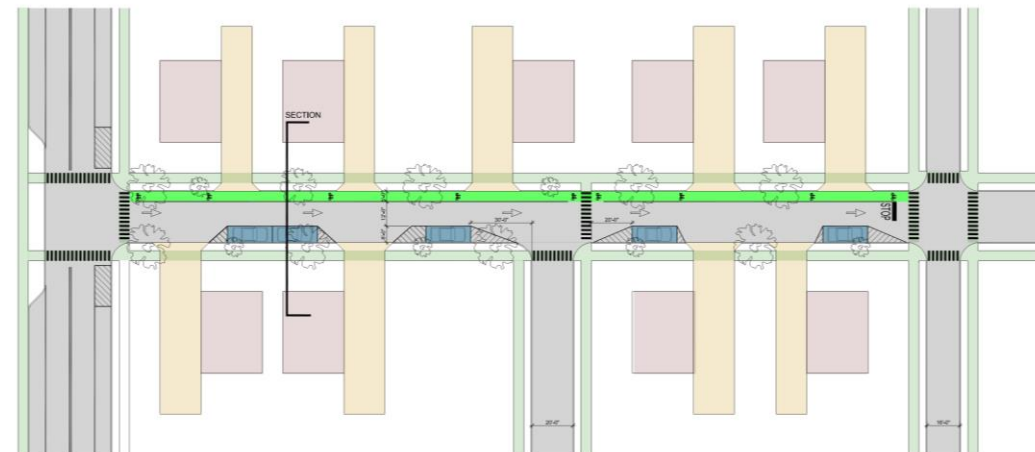

ONE WAY NEIGHBORHOOD STREET WITH ON-STREET PARKING & BIKE LANE



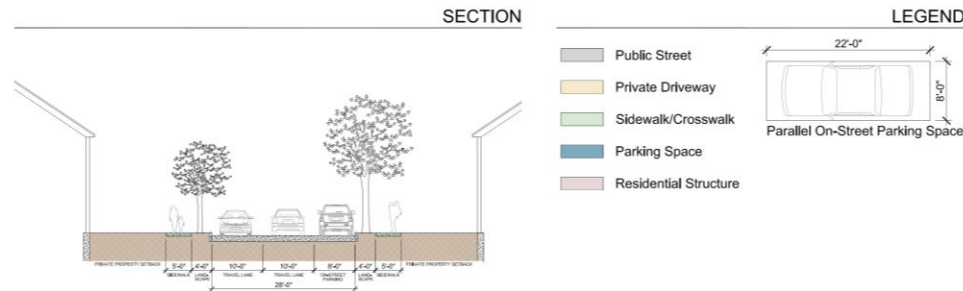
Adding On-Street Parking – Example with 28' Width

- Allows for two-way traffic with 10' travel lanes, as well as 8' parking lane
- Alternatively, could be one-way traffic with 12' travel lane and parking on both sides of street

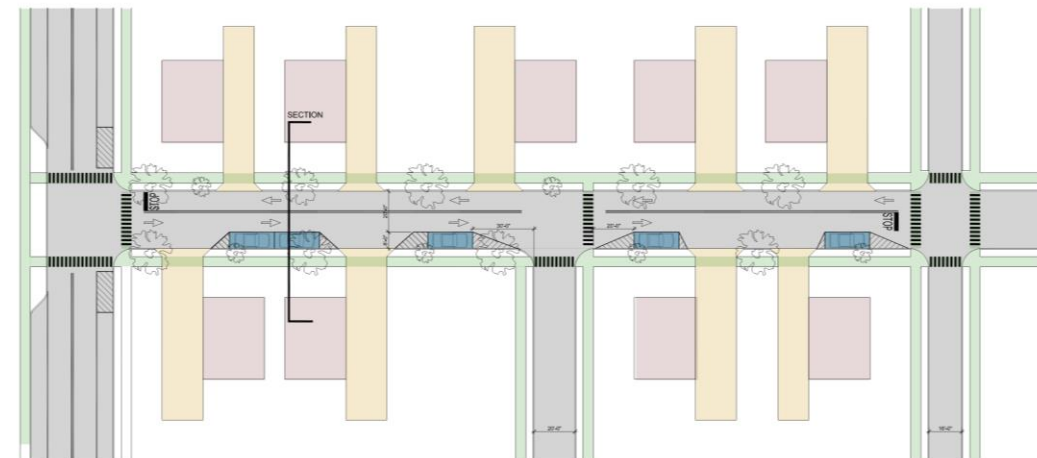

Other Ideas

- Parking Benefit Districts
 - Some/all revenue is returned to area for streetscape or other improvements
- Residential Permit Program
 - Becoming easier to administer and enforce
