# Pool Filling FAQs



## PRICING

Charge for Water/Sewer is **\$10.09** per hundred cubic foot (HCF=750 gallons of water)




Charge for water NOT discharged into sewer system (bulk water) is **\$4.78** per HCF



Service charge for City personnel to remove meter, install spacer and later return to reinstall meter is a total charge of **\$90.**

## REMINDER



When emptying your pool water for the season remember **NOT** to feed water into any nearby storm drains/catch basins as remaining chemicals can **contaminate** local water.

Instead, empty pool water onto your lawn and let it seep into the ground. (chemicals will be diluted enough to be safe.)

Thank you for your compliance with this matter.

## SHOULD YOU REQUEST TO HAVE YOUR METER PULLED?

Either way you'll pay for the water – but it may prove to be less expensive to pay the water/sewer charges rather than to incur the service charges to remove and re-install your meter.

*If your pool needs...*

**Less than 12,715 gallons**, it will be less expensive to use your water through your meter and pay water/sewer charges.

**More than 12,715 gallons**, it will be less expensive for you to contact the City to have your meter temporarily removed and a spacer installed. No sewer charge is applied. Please call **603-352-3239** to schedule an appointment to have your water meter temporarily removed and a spacer installed.
