COVID Policies and Procedures

- Masks are required while in the recreation center. The exception will be when participants are playing a game and/or scrimmage, they will be allowed to remove their masks.
- All players, coaches, and volunteers will be required to answer screening questions upon entering the building in line with NH Amateur & Youth Sports Guidance.
- Only players and coaches will be permitted to enter the gym. Unfortunately we will not be allowing spectators.
- The gym will have one way travel. Teams will enter the gym using the doors at the far end of the hallway and exit the gym using the front doors.
- Teams must exit the gym promptly. Teams may not overlap in the gym. Please do not arrive more than 10 minutes before your teams allotted time.
- Coaches will be provided with hand sanitizer and players and coaches will be required to hand sanitize at the beginning, middle, and end of each meeting
- Players will place equipment and belongings 6 feet apart. Chairs will be used in place of benches and will be placed 6 feet apart.
- Social distancing will be encouraged and practiced when not involved in game play
- Coaches, youth, and parents will be educated and trained on safety practices including hygiene, sanitation, face coverings and illness policies.
- Shared equipment will be cleaned and disinfected according to CDC guidance.
- Teams will have their own equipment for practice that will not be shared between groups. Equipment will be cleaned and sanitized following CDC guidelines
- All participants need to bring their own water bottles, no sharing of water or shared water jugs are permitted.
- Guidelines are subject to change based on state requirements
